Evangelism & Prayer Quick Reference Guide

Purpose: Share the love of Jesus with grace, humility, and boldness. Trust the Holy Spirit to lead every conversation.

1. Approach

- Smile, make eye contact.
- Greet: "Hi! We're here sharing God's love. How's your day going?"
- Offer: Water, snacks, tracts, and prayer.

Sample Openers:

- "Can we pray for you?"
- "May I ask about your spiritual journey?"
- "Would you like to hear how Jesus changed my life?"

2. Gospel Presentation (2-Minute Version)

- 1. **God loves you** and desires a relationship with you (John 3:16).
- 2. **Sin separates us** from God (Romans 3:23).
- 3. **Jesus died** and rose to offer forgiveness (Romans 5:8).
- 4. **Trust in Him** through repentance and faith (Acts 3:19).

Invitation: "Would you like to pray to trust Jesus today?"

3. Salvation Prayer

"Dear Jesus, I know I'm a sinner and need You. Thank You for dying for me and rising again. I trust You as my Savior and want to follow You. Forgive me and make me new. Amen."

4. Handling Questions

"Does God hate me?"

"No. God loves you deeply and wants a relationship with you."

"Why is [X] a sin?"

• "The Bible teaches God's design for [X], but the greatest truth is we all need Jesus' forgiveness."

"Why are you here?"

• "Jesus changed my life, and I want to share His love with others."

5. Dealing with Hostility

- Stay calm, respectful, and kind.
- "I hear you. I respect your view. I'll pray for you."
- Walk away if necessary.

6. Offering Prayer

- Ask: "May I pray for you?"
- Keep prayers short, sincere, Spirit-led.

Sample Prayer:

"Father, thank You for *[name]*. Please bring peace and show Your love. In Jesus' name, Amen."

7. Safety Guidelines

- Always in teams of 2-3.
- Stay in visible, public areas.
- Check in regularly with team leader.
- Respect boundaries. Walk away from hostile situations.

8. Follow-Up

- Offer church contact info, invite to services or Bible study.
- Pray for every person you speak with.
